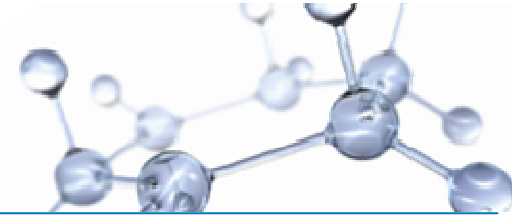


# Product Vessel Planner

ExxonMobil is seeking a Products Vessel planner for its Global Marine Transportation Optimization business, located in Brussels.

Global Marine Transportation and Optimization is responsible for the provision of shipping services at optimal cost. This includes the use of Time chartered ships, Contracts of Affreightment and Spot ini-chartered ships for crude products and LPG. The Product Vessel Planner will be responsible for scheduling, planning and coordinating all aspects for marine operations, related to spot and term contracts. The prime goal is to optimize the ship movements with the business unit's supply organizations and the ship owners. The Product Vessel Planner will act as contact between affiliate and counter party, ensures that all operational and documentation requirements are completed accurately and in a timely manner, liaises with traders, charterers, affiliates and third parties to provide information on shipping opportunities. Vessel planning comprises up to several hundred vessel voyages per year, with the cargo plus marine freight components valued in the multi-millions of dollars/year. As a consequence, the Products vessel planner position is a critical operational role.
